



COVID Update - 15th October

Dear Students, Parents and Carers

We have been notified today that three students have received positive test results. I have contacted the local health protection team and followed their advice in identifying students who need to isolate. We have spoken to all of these students in person, where possible, and emailed them so that they are clear on what they need to do.

The local health protection team have again told me that they are satisfied with our planning and response and that given increasing infection rates nationally and locally and the prevalence of cases in local educational institutions, it is inevitable that we too will have cases.

Given the disruption that our students have suffered to their education since March I remain convinced that we need to give them the opportunity of a full education for as long as are advised it is safe to do so. Nevertheless, I have asked to meet with a Health Protection Consultant tomorrow so that we can review our risk assessment in detail and hopefully they will be able to provide me with further reassurance.

I will provide you with an update tomorrow.
