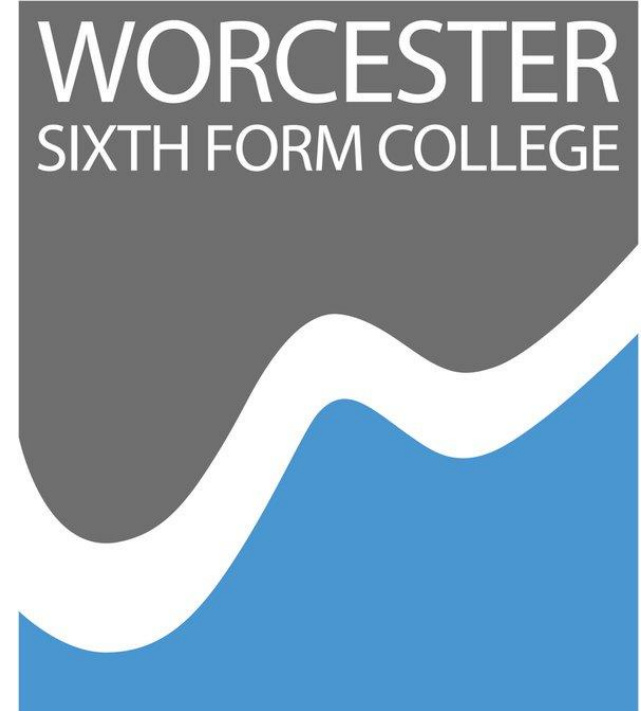

## The Structure

- 4 lessons a week (65 mins)
- Weekly practice with a teacher for the oral component; Year 1: 15 mins in a group of 2 people, year 2: 10 minutes individually
- Exams in the second year (May/ June)
  - Paper 1 - Listening, Reading, Translation into English
  - Paper 2 - Translation into the target language. Writing piece on the film studied
  - Paper 3 - Speaking (on two of the topics studied)
