
This course consists of a series of experimental workshops through which you will explore...

Year 1 – Coursework Portfolio

This begins with a series of experimental workshops to improve drawing and painting techniques including mixed media, oil paint and print making. In response to a set of themes you will create a collection of drawings, paintings and experimental pieces. You will evidence your work using a sketchbook or display series of boards.

Year 2 – Coursework Portfolio

This year begins with a chosen theme that you will provide visual evidence through drawing, painting and other creative studies using a variety of techniques and processes. All work will be based on the assessment objectives. You will demonstrate the journey you have made by producing a final outcome.

In this year you will also write a 3,000 word personal investigation on a chosen theme.

Controlled Assignment (exam)

The Controlled Assignment is a personal response to an exam paper.

The marks for the course are as follows:

Coursework 60% Controlled Assignment 40%

Please note that progression through the course is dependent on the successful completion of each project within the deadlines



Materials and Equipment

The Fine Art course uses an amount of materials and resources. You will have to pay for the art materials before the course starts and this will enable you to have access to all the items you will need throughout the year.

The materials will include:

- A1 quality portfolio folder
- A1 presentation boards
- Sketchbook
- Paper
- Canvas
- Access to: pencils, pens, oil/ acrylic paints, inks, printing materials

At the end of the year you will have all your work to keep and take to Foundation and Degree interviews.
