


	Top strategies for final exam preparation (students should already have some notes on flash cards): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Attempting past papers. 2. One to one discussion with teacher(s). 3. Reading model answers from the textbook and past papers. 4. Writing exam answers under timed conditions. 5. Using past exam questions, mark schemes and examiner's reports to plan answers. 6. Marking your own work using the mark scheme. 7. Group / pair work such as 'quick quizzes'. 8. Create a glossary for Unit 2 and Unit 4. 9. Compare model answers against own. 10. Handing in additional work for marking. 11. Tracking which Assessment Criteria links to past exam questions.
