Top strategies for final exam preparation (students should already have consolidated their course notes and flash cards)

- Revise in small chunks for the vocabulary/ test yourself in writing as well as orally/ get someone to test you. Use or make quizlets.
- Do mind maps for ideas, opinions and cultural facts to prepare for the oral exam
- Record yourself (IRP/ oral cards) and listen to it afterwards
- Write detailed plans or full lengths essays for the Film and Literary essays (list of essays at the back of the booklets)
- Do and re-do Past Papers from Edexcel. Use other exam boards too (AQA/Eduqas)
- Do 2 translations a week from the pack of translations/ check the answers/ note and learn unknown vocabulary
