	<b>Top strategies for final exam preparation (students should already have consolidated their course notes and flash cards)</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Past paper practice (use the website to download and attempt questions). Start by using notes and support. Develop to removing support and then finally move to timed essays without support.</li><li>- Create topic summary knowledge sheets</li><li>- Work through the potential questions sheets.</li></ul>
