



It is made up of 40% exam and 60% NEA (Non examined assessments)

HEALTH AND SOCIAL CARE OCR 3 A Levels

We are offering the AAQ Health and Social Care Level 3 (**Equivalent to 1 A Levels**) this will allow them to just study Health and Social Care. The course is made up of 40% exams and 60% coursework.

OUR APPROACH TO TEACHING AND LEARNING

All lessons are planned to meet and develop the needs of our learners.

As a teaching team we have developed and update our breadth of teaching resources and learning materials covering all units and use our Microsoft teams resources in and outside of the classroom.

Practical lessons = Kinesthetic learning e.g. Developing Health Promotion Campaigns, dissecting a heart, communicating using different methods

Using theory to practice while undertaking work experience and reverse this to reflect back on the work placement.

Use of relevant trips and visiting speakers (e.g. Social Worker, Midwife/Health Visitor, Sexual Health Nurse)

Level 3 Alternative Academic Qualification OCR in Health and Social Care Extended Certificate.

The courses above will *“provide learners with the skills, knowledge and understanding that will allow them to progress onto **Higher Education** on a health and social care-related programme such as **Health and Social Care, Nursing, Social Work or Early Childhood Studies**. Learners will learn by applying their skills, knowledge and understanding to tasks or activities that are relevant to what happens in health, social care and child care workplaces.”*
